

# Coding – Summary Report

## (Addendum to MSL Laboratory Operations TP Case for Endorsement Release 2.0)

### Components for Endorsement

Further to the MSL Laboratory Operations Case for Endorsement, IBSA Manufacturing and the Process Manufacturing, Recreational Vehicles and Laboratory IRC request the endorsement of the following additional three qualifications.

- MSL20118 Certificate II in Sampling and Measurement
- MSL30118 Certificate III in Laboratory Skills
- MSL60118 Advanced Diploma of Laboratory Operations

### Background

Following the AISC decision at their 20 February 2018 meeting, the MSL Laboratory Operations Training Package was endorsed subject to the update of unit codes to be compliant with the 2012 Standards for Training Packages. Subsequent qualification code changes are required where updated units are packaged as core units in the respective qualifications. These are outlined in Attachment A.

### Further consultation

Consultation with the following stakeholders was undertaken, as agreed with the AISC Secretariat:

- an email alert was sent to the Process Manufacturing, Recreational Vehicles and Laboratory Operations Industry Reference Committee (IRC) inviting feedback on the impact of the changes
- an email alert was sent to the State and Territory Training Authorities, and RTOs, outlining the code changes and inviting feedback on the impact of the changes
- the IBSA website was updated to provide advice to stakeholders about the extent of the code changes.

Feedback was received from the following organisations, all of which were supportive of the changes:

- Dalton Training Services
- Gold Coast TAFE
- Department of Training and Workforce Development (Western Australia)
- Department of Trade, Business and Innovation (Northern Territory).

There are no outstanding or unresolved issues or feedback.
